We believed we reached a fair and equitable settlement with Arc Resources and they have been commended for the way in which they cooperated with us to achieve the goals we felt were right and proper for both parties. There appears to be a lot of hostility between property owners and oil companies now in your area and the agreement we reached with Arc Resources could be used as a model for future negotiations with property owners and oil companies.

One thing we do feel that needs to be done differently is that once gas plants or oil or gas wells are intended to be established in an area that not just the property owners where these sites will be established be contacted but ALL property owners within close proximity of these sites. Then some process of sharing concerns or questions regarding these sites be established. This would go a long way in alleviating hostilities between property owners and resource based companies.
