TOPIC: Request to make a presentation.

Dear Chair and Directors,

On behalf of the South Peace Seniors Access Services Society (S.P.S.A.S.S.) I would like to request a meeting with the Chair and Directors of the Peace River Regional District to make a presentation about S.P.S.A.S.S.

The purpose of the meeting would be to make a presentation about the goals of S.P.S.A.S.S. and the purpose of an Access Centre for seniors. In addition, the society wishes to seek funding for 2010 from the Peace River Regional District to print and distribute a South Peace Health Guide. The guide would be similar in format to the one completed for the North Peace under the leadership of S.O.N.S., but would have information pertinent for Dawson Creek, Chetwynd, Tumbler Ridge and contiguous rural areas.

The cost of printing 10000 copies of the South Peace Health Guide would be in the order of \$ 20000 and the cost of distributing the health guide through Canada Post would be in the order of \$2000. Extra copies would be placed in key health locations through out the South Peace Region.

I have attached to this memorandum a general information brochure and more detailed information concerning the centre and its proposed budgets for 2010 to 2012.

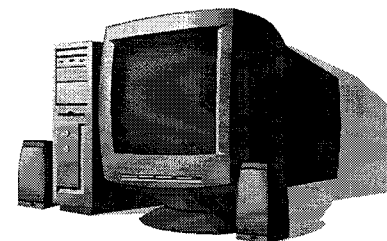
Map to Seniors Access Centre
