BC Transmission Corporation (the Crown corporation that manages BC's publicly owned transmission assets) requests time on February 25, 2010, for a delegation to present to the Peace River Regional District Board of Directors.

BCTC is planning some projects in the Chetwynd and Dawson Creek area to meet load growth in the area and also to provide a point of interconnection for anticipated new wind developments. Specifically, we are studying a new transmission circuit that would originate approximately 19 km east of Chetwynd and terminate at Dawson Creek Substation.

Our delegation would consist of Project Manager Brooke Dutka and me. The purpose would be to discuss the planned project and to obtain the Board's input at this early stage of project definition.

In addition, some new infrastructure will be installed at Dawson Creek Substation over the next two years, and we will provide information on those projects as well.
