Margit Weitzel stated that the community is very happy with the paved road, but is concerned about the lack of maintenance, particularly at the Goat Hill slide area.

Lorraine Westergaard referred to the dangerous slide area between km 19 and 22 where flaggers have been stationed for weeks. She felt they were not doing a good job of warning travellers of the dangerous single lane ahead and wondered if lights could have been installed, at less cost to the taxpayers.

The Directors asked the residents a few questions about wildlife in the area, and particularly if wolves were a problem. They thought that only 1 to 2% of domestic cattle were being killed by wolves.

Discussion ensued about the inability to heat the community hall and the resulting absence of water and sewer facilities, and how a natural gas distribution system could be of benefit to the area.
