

**PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT  
By-Law No. 1900, 2010**

---

A by-law to impose fees for the disposal of solid waste  
at Regional District Solid Waste facilities

---

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District did, pursuant to the Province of B.C. Local Government Act, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 323 adopt the "Solid Waste Regulation By-law No. 1899, 2010";

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as "Solid Waste Disposal Fee By-Law No. 1900, 2010."
2. Every person disposing of Solid Waste at a transfer station, or a landfill site shall pay the applicable fees and other charges to the Regional District.
3. The fees and other charges applicable in relation to the disposal of Solid Waste at a Landfill Site or a Transfer Station, shall be as set out in Schedule 'A' and 'B', forming part of this by-law.
4. Where fees are collected, in the event that there are no scales provided at a Landfill Site or Transfer Station or the scales provided are not operational, the fees shall be as set out in Schedule 'B'.
5. Capitalized items in this by-law have the meaning attributed to them in Section 2 of "Solid Waste Regulation By-law No. 1899, 2010."
6. "Solid Waste Regulations and Fees Amendment By-law No. 1627, 2006" is hereby repealed.

<b>Minimum Fees:</b> 0 -125 kg: \$3.00 126 - 250 kg: \$6.00	
TYPE	Applicable Fees and Other Charges
1. Household Waste	\$35.00 per tonne
2. Wood Waste	\$35.00 per tonne
3. Metal Waste	\$35.00 per tonne
4. Tire categories: Passenger Vehicle, Light Truck, Small RV, Golf Cart, Motorcycle, All Terrain Vehicle, Forklift, Small Utility Trailer, Bobcat/Skid Steer (16" and under), and Free-Rolling Farm tires (16" and under).	\$35.00 per tonne plus \$3.00 per tire
5. Animal Carcasses not listed in Livestock Act or Wildlife Act (cats, dogs)	\$35.00 per tonne

2. Household furniture	\$35.00 per tonne
3. Household appliances containing/not containing Ozone Depleting Substances	\$35.00 per tonne
4. Tire categories: Medium Truck, Large RV (not marked "P or LT"), Medium Agricultural (16.5" – 25.5").	\$35.00 per tonne plus \$7.00 per tire
5. Tire categories: Forklift, Bobcat/Skid Steer (16.5" and over), Logger/Skidder, Large Agricultural Drive tires (26" and over).	\$35.00 per tonne plus \$28.00 per tire
6. Soils, clean concrete rubble (no rebar)	\$0.00 per tonne
7. Stripped vehicle hulks	\$70.00 per tonne
8. Unstripped vehicle hulks	\$70.00 per tonne plus \$140.00 per hulk
9. All other controlled waste	\$70.00 per tonne
10. Demolition, land clearing, and construction waste	\$70.00 per tonne

	<b>TYPE</b>	<b>Applicable Fees and Other Charges</b>
1.	Specified Risk Material – (SRM as defined by the Canadian Food Inspection Agency)	\$105.00 per tonne
2.	Animal Carcasses listed in Livestock Act or Wildlife Act (horses, non-SRM cows, moose, deer, etc)	\$105.00 per tonne
3.	Lead Acid Batteries	\$ 35.00 per tonne
4.	All other Restricted Waste	\$105.00 per tonne
5.	Commercially generated cardboard	\$105.00 per tonne

**Fees and Other Charges – Based on Volume**  
**Effective July 1, 2010**

<b>PART I - REGULAR WASTE</b>	
	<b>Minimum Fee: \$3.00</b>
<b>TYPE</b>	<b>Applicable Fees and Other Charges</b>
1. Household Waste	\$3.00 per cubic metre
2. Tire categories: Passenger Vehicle, Light Truck, Small RV, Golf Cart, Motorcycle, All Terrain Vehicle, Forklift, Small Utility Trailer, Bobcat/Skid Steer (16" and under), and Free-Rolling Farm tires (16" and under).	\$5.00 per tire
3. Animal Carcasses not listed in the Livestock Act or the Wildlife Act (cats, dogs, etc.)	\$7.00 per carcass
4. All other regular waste	\$3.00 per cubic metre

Volume measurement will be applied as follows:

- Pickup truck, 2 wheeled trailer or passenger vehicle trunk equals 1 cubic metre.
- Pickup truck or 2 wheeled trailer with extended side walls is 80% of measured volume.
- All other truck boxes or trailers are 80% of measured volume.

5.	Tire categories: Forklift, Bobcat/Skid Steer (16.5" and over), Logger/Skidder, Large Agricultural Drive tires (26" and over).	\$3.00 per cubic metre plus \$46.00 per tire
7.	Soils	\$0.00 per cubic metre
8.	Stripped vehicle hulks	\$70.00 per hulk
9.	Unstripped vehicle hulks	\$210.00 per hulk
10.	All other controlled waste	\$7.00 per cubic metre
