



## PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT New Coupon Program for Waste Cleanup

The Peace River Regional District is changing its spring and fall bulky waste cleanup program to reduce costs and improve service to the public. A new coupon system will be introduced to replace the traditional cleanup program.

In mid-May, a set of 4 coupons will be mailed to all landowners with improvements (i.e. buildings/barn), in both rural and municipal areas of the Regional District. These coupons will provide for the following:

- Each coupon entitles the bearer to dispose of up to 250 kilograms of eligible residential waste free-of-charge, for a total weight exemption of 1 tonne (1000 kg or 2200 lbs);
- Coupons can be used at any time of the year, between May 1<sup>st</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup> of the following year;
- Coupons are for residential waste only, not commercial or industrial waste;
- Coupons can only be used at the Bessborough, Chetwynd, Fort St. John, and Rose Prairie landfills as well as the Dawson Creek transfer station;
- A combination of coupons and cash can be used;
- Ineligible waste materials include vehicle hulks, tires on rims, tires over 24.5 inches inner diameter, animal carcasses listed in the *Wildlife Act* or *Livestock Act*, Special Waste, and Prohibited Waste as defined under the Regional District's [Solid Waste Regulation By-law No. 1927, 2011](#). All other waste disposal rules and regulations apply.
- For those waste materials that are charged both by the piece and by their weight, such as automotive batteries and tires, a fee exemption will be given on their weight up to the coupon limit, but will still be charged by the piece. Tires and batteries are managed under BC product stewardship programs and can be returned to designated depots within the district free-of-charge. **IMPORTANT! Wood, metal, tires, and automotive batteries must be separated and placed into designated areas at the landfills or Dawson Creek transfer station.**
