On Saturday, January 9, 2010 the Peace River Regional District (PRRD) Electoral Area 'D' Director, Wayne Hiebert, was pleased to present a cheque in the amount of \$100,000 to the Village of Pouce Coupe, represented by Mayor Lyman Clark, to assist in the construction of the Village's new fire hall.

In 2009 The Village of Pouce Coupe benefited from nearly \$1 million in federal and provincial funding to help build local infrastructure and provide basic services to local residents. The new fire hall, which opened its doors on October 29, 2009, replaced the old fire hall, supporting the on-going emergency services program and reducing operation and maintenance costs as well as greenhouse gas emissions.

Funds presented by Mr. Hiebert were provided from the Electoral Area 'D' Fair Share fund. The Pouce Coupe Volunteer Fire Department provides fire protection services to rural residents within the Pouce Coupe Fire Protection Service Area.
