Peace River Regional District Bylaw No. 1328, 2000

A bylaw to establish a service within a defined portion of Electoral Area 'D' for the provision of Sewage Collection

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District may, by bylaw, pursuant to the <u>Local Government Act</u>, establish and operate any service the Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to establish a service for the purpose of providing a sewage collection service for the benefit of the residents of the service area;

AND WHEREAS the Board has received a petition pursuant to the <u>Local Government Act</u> requesting the installation and operation of a sewage collection system in a defined portion of Electoral Area 'D', and such petition has been determined to be sufficient pursuant to the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board has authorized the approval of the electors required under Section 801(1)(b) to be given on behalf of the electors in accordance with the <u>Local Government Act</u>;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Electoral Area 'D' has consented, in writing, to the adoption of the bylaw in accordance with the <u>Local Government Act</u>;

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been obtained pursuant to the <u>Local</u> Government Act;

AND THEREFORE, the Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Service Being Established

1. The Service hereby established under this bylaw is a sewage collection system for the benefit of the residents of a defined portion of Electoral Area 'D'.

Service Area Boundaries

2. The boundaries of the Service Area are that portion of Electoral Area 'D' as graphically represented on the map attached as Schedule "A" to this bylaw, hereinafter referred to as the "Chilton Subdivision".

Participating Areas

3. The participating area is Electoral Area 'D'.

Cost Recovery

- 4. The annual cost of providing the Service within the service area boundary as defined in Part 2 Service Area Boundaries, and shown on Schedule A, shall be recovered by one of more of the following:
 - a) A parcel tax imposed pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Act;
 - b) Fees and charges imposed pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Act
 - c) Revenues raised by other means authorized by the Local Government Act, or another Act;
 - d) Revenues raised by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant, or otherwise."

Requisition

5. The maximum amount that may requisitioned for the service is \$100,000.

Citation

6. This bylaw may be cited as "Chilton Subdivision Sewage Collection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1328, 2000".
