



EVACUATION ORDER # 1

Old Fort Landslide

Electoral Area C

April 20, 2026, at 1900 (7:00 p.m.)

Whereas a state of local emergency was declared on April 20, 2026, by Peace River Regional District *pursuant* to Section 95 of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* due to the landslide within the area of *Electoral Area C* in the *Peace River Regional District*.

And whereas Section 107 (1)(c) and (d) of the *Emergency and Disaster Management Act* authorizes requiring evacuations in relation to a declared state of local emergency, making arrangements for the adequate care and protection of evacuated persons and animals, and controlling travel to or from an area;

And whereas the landslide is a significant threat to the health, safety, and welfare of persons, such that an evacuation and controlling travel is necessary to minimize threats;

This **Evacuation Order** has been issued by Peace River Regional District and is **effective as of April 20, 2026, at 1900 (7:00 p.m.)** for the following areas:

- For all properties east of, but not including, 7711 Old Fort Road

YOU MUST LEAVE THE AREA IMMEDIATELY

Members of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP) and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

A person must not enter any of the area identified above and in the attached map for purposes of residing, occupying, or visiting the area.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- Follow the travel route provided and register at: Pomeroy Sports Centre (9324 96 St., Fort St. John), second floor, East lobby.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area, advise the person providing this notice or call 1-800-670-7773.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.



PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT

- Gather your family and, if you have room, take a neighbour or someone needing transportation. Do not use more vehicles than you have to.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available. Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Do not use the telephone unless you need emergency service.

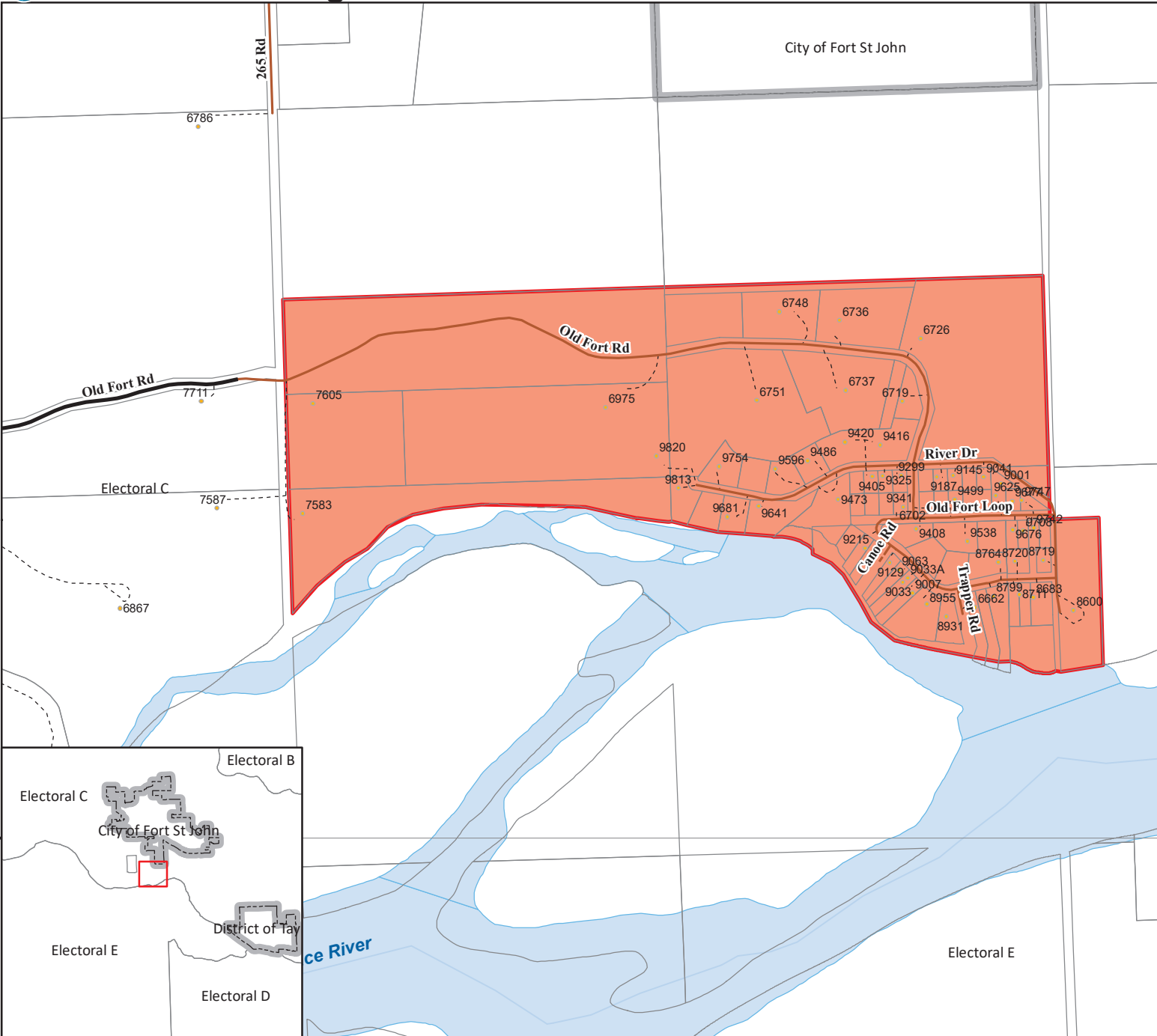
