Bylaw No. 678, 1990

A bylaw to establish a Local Service to provide a Sewage
Collection, Conveyance, Treatment and Disposal System
within Electoral Area 'C' and 'B'

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District may, by bylaw, establish and operate a Local Service under the provisions of Section 788 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to establish a Local Service for the purpose of providing a Sewage Collection, Conveyance, Treatment and Disposal System for the benefit of the residents of the Local Service Area;

AND WHEREAS the Board has published a notice under Section 797(2) of the Municipal Act that it intends to establish a Local Service in Electoral Area 'C' and 'B';

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities is required under Section 795(1)(a) of the Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Service Being Established

1. The Local Service hereby established under this bylaw and to be operated is the Collection, Conveyance, Treatment and Disposal of Sewage.

Service Area Boundaries

2. The Local Service Area is contained within the boundary shown on the plan annexed hereto as Schedule 'A'.

Cost Recovery

3. The operating, capital and debt servicing cost of providing the Service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:
 - a) imposition of fees and other charges;
 - b) parcel taxes imposed in accordance with Division 4.3 of the Local Government Act;
 - c) revenues raised by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise; and
 - d) revenues raised by other means authorized by the Local Government Act or another Act."

Requisition Limit

4. Section 4 of "Charlie Lake Sewage Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 678, 1990" is deleted and the following substituted:

"Requisition Limit

4. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned under Section 3 for the service provided under Section 1, in accordance with the Municipal Act, is:
 - a) under Section 794(2)(a) of the Municipal Act, the product of a property value tax of \$12.357 for each \$1,000 of net taxable value of land and improvements included in the service area,

whichever is the greater."

Citation

5. This bylaw may be cited as "Charlie Lake Sewage Local Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 678, 1990."

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 24th day of May, 1990.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 24th day of May, 1990.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 24th day of May, 1990.

APPROVED by the Inspector of Municipalities this 14th day of June, 1990.

The assent of Electoral Area 'C' and 'B' was obtained by counter petition this 31st day of July, 1990.

RECONSIDERED, FINALLY PASSED AND ADOPTED, with the consent of at least two-thirds of the participants this 31st day of July, 1990.

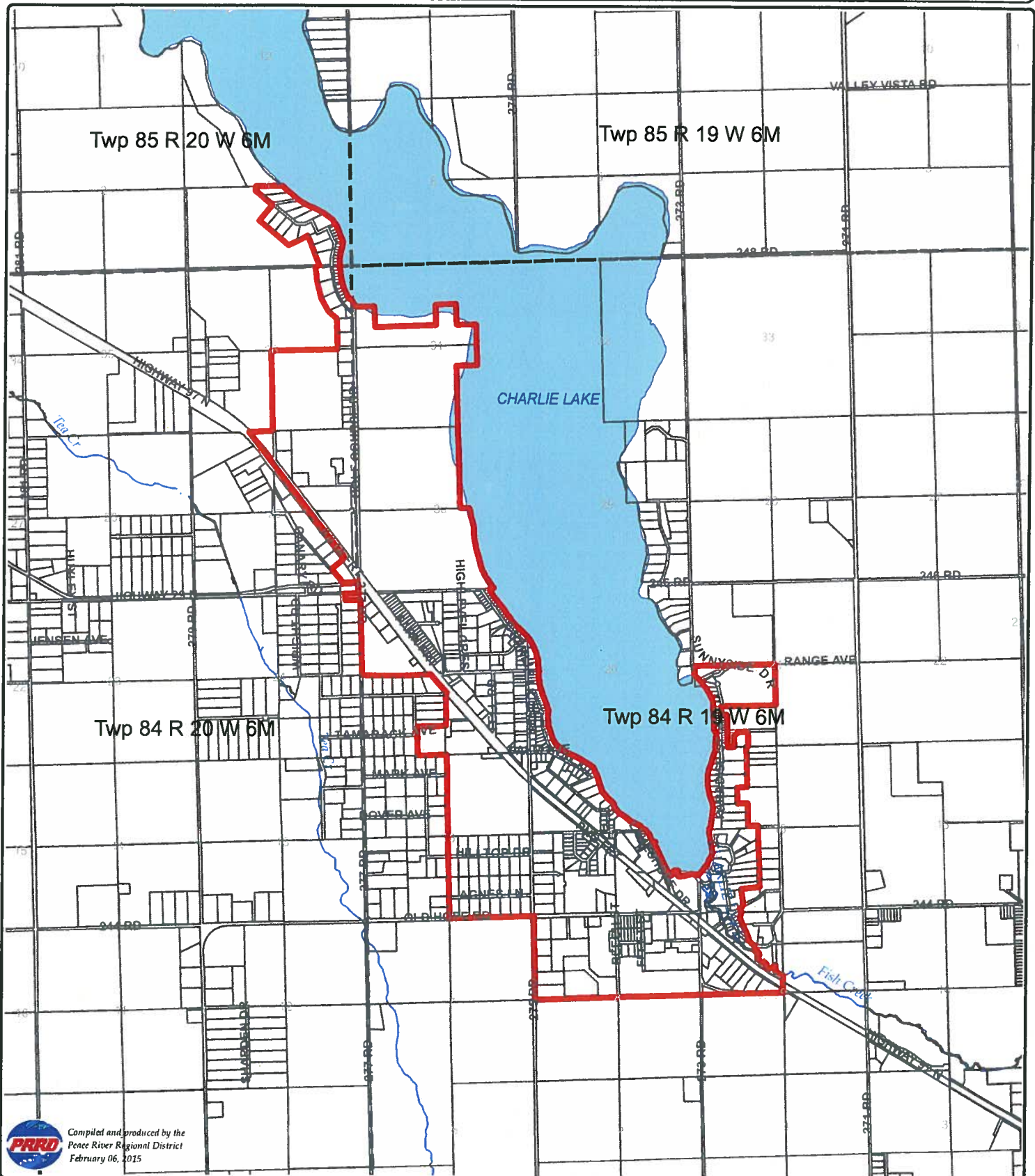
Schedule 'A' – Service Area Boundary is attached
