

PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT
Bylaw No. 2274, 2016

A by-law to authorize establishing operating reserve funds for
various service/functions of the Peace River Regional District

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District, pursuant to bylaw, supplementary Letters Patent or the *Local Government Act* established various service/functions as indicated on Schedule 'A', attached to and forming part of this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS reserve funds may be established under the provisions of Section 377 of the *Local Government Act*;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to establish reserves for many of the Regional District's service/function for unexpected costs, special projects, and extraordinary operational requirements;

NOW THEREFORE the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Operating Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 2274, 2016."
2. "Operating Reserve Fund Establishment Bylaw No. 2033, 2012" is hereby repealed.
3. Money, not to exceed the amounts stated on Schedule 'A', attached to and forming part of this bylaw, may be paid into separate interest earning reserve funds.
4. The moneys set aside in Section 3 may be invested in the manner provided by the *Local Government Act*. All funds, including interest earned, shall be used exclusively for the benefit of the service/function as indicated on Schedule 'A'
