**Peace River Regional District
Bylaw No. 1609, 2005**

A bylaw to establish a service within a defined portion of
Electoral Area 'D' for the provision of Sewage Collection

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District may, by bylaw, pursuant to the Local Government Act, establish and operate any service the Board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Board wishes to establish a sewage collection service for the benefit of the residents of the service area established by this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Board has received a petition pursuant to the Local Government Act requesting the installation and operation of a sewage collection system in a defined portion of Electoral Area 'D', and such petition has been determined to be sufficient pursuant to Section 212 of the Community Charter;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board has authorized the approval of the participating area required under the Local Government Act to be given on behalf of the electors in accordance with the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the Director of Electoral Area 'D' has consented, in writing, to the adoption of the bylaw in accordance with the Local Government Act;

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been obtained pursuant to the Local Government Act;

AND THEREFORE, the Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

Service Being Established

1. The Service established under this bylaw is to provide a sewage collection system for the benefit of the residents of a defined portion of Electoral Area 'D'.

Service Area Boundaries

2. The boundaries of the Service Area are those portions of Electoral Area 'D' as outlined in heavy black line on the map attached as Schedule "A" to this bylaw.

Participating Areas

3. The participating area is Electoral Area D.

Cost Recovery

4. The Regional District may recover the costs of the sewage collection service by means of fees and charges imposed under the Local Government Act and by parcel taxes in the Service Area described in Section 2.
5. The maximum amount that may be requisitioned for the service is \$21,250, to be recovered annually via parcel tax.
