Under BC Law, Building Permits that involve any excavation must submit a *Site Disclosure Statement* which discloses the history of the land, specifically if ANY of the commercial or industrial uses/activities listed in the *Contaminated Sites Regulation* (*Schedule 2*) took place.

If the owner can attest that none of these activities happened on the land, they may opt to complete the **Contaminated Site Declaration Form** on page 3 of the Building Permit application. Otherwise, they must complete the provincial **Schedule 1 Site Disclosure Statement**.
