BY-LAW NO. 1125, 1998

A by-law to provide for the Enforcement of
Noise Regulations

The Regional Board of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts
as follows:

1. Ticket Information By-law No. 933, 1995 is amended by substituting for Schedule 'A' to that by-law schedule 'A' attached to and forming part of this By-law.
2. Ticket Information By-law No. 933, 1995 is further amended by adding Schedule "C" attached to and forming part of this By-law.
3. This by-law may be cited as "Ticket Information By-law No. 993, 1995 Amendment By-law No. 1125, 1998".

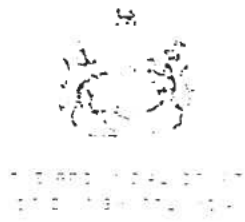

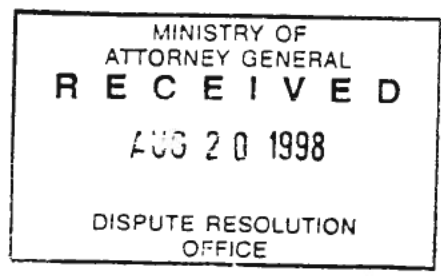

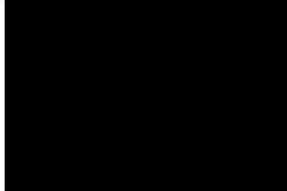
