## PEACE RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW No. 2504, 2022

A bylaw to revise the tax rate for Charlie Lake Fire Protection Specified Area Bylaw No. 1360, 2001

WHEREAS the Regional Board adopted the "Charlie Lake Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1360, 2001" to establish a rural fire protection and suppression service in the rural area;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board wishes to amend Bylaw No. 1360, 2001 to increase the requisition limits for the service;

AND WHEREAS the written consent of the participants has been obtained pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act*;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Peace River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

## **SECTION 1 – CITATION**

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "Charlie Lake Fire Protection Service Amendment (Tax Rate) Bylaw No. 2504, 2022".
- 2. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court, the invalid portion shall be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

## **SECTION 2 – TEXT AMENDMENTS**

Charlie Lake Fire Protection Service Area Establishment Bylaw No. 1360, 2001, is hereby amended as follows:

3. Section 4 titled <u>Requisition Limitation</u> is deleted in its entirety and a new Section 4 is inserted in its place that reads as follows:

## Maximum Requisition

4. The maximum requisition limit that may be requisitioned in any one year for the service is the greater of \$1,422,578 or an amount equal to the amount that could be raised by a property value tax of \$1.57/\$1,000 when applied to the net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area.
